# STAGE RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP 2017

## Championship Rules

1. Following a 'Gap Year' in 2016, welcome to Club RallySport West's 'New-Look' Stage Rally Championship 2017. The rules for 2017 have been changed to provide you with the opportunity to choose the events you wish to do.
2. The championship will consist of 6 qualifying events, the first of which will be the 'BREAN STAGES RALLY', thereafter you can choose and claim points for 5 other rallies you wish to enter during the year. There will be no registration fee and no requirement to register for 2017.
3. There are two championships, one for drivers and one for co-drivers registration for the championships is not necessary. The championship co-ordinator will allocate points automatically from the event results.
4. To score points in the series:
  - a. You must be a member of CRSW.
  - b. **You MUST enter the event under CRSW in order to qualify for points in the championship.** (You can also enter an event under a dual club if appropriate, ie, CRSW/Another Club).
  - c. **You should inform the Championship Co-ordinator prior to the rally you are entering in order that an entry list/ results can be downloaded from the rally website and points allocated.**
  - d. You must display a minimum of two CRSW decals on the car (one each side of the car).
5. Points will be awarded as indicated at paragraph 8 of these rules and will be published on a regular basis on the club facebook page.

6. The Championship year will run from 1 January to 31 December.
7. Contenders must be current members of CRSW.
- 8.. Points in the championship will be awarded automatically as follows:

(a) Start	=	10 points

(b) Finish overall	=	1st CRSW = 15 points
		2nd CRSW = 14 points
		3rd CRSW = 13 points
		Then so on down to 1 point
9. Points will be awarded by the Club Championship Points Co-ordinator from the results downloaded from the respective rally website. If these are not available online, contenders must therefore provide the Championship Co-ordinator with an entry list (showing entry under CRSW) and a set of final results within 14 days of the chosen event.
10. In the event of any disagreement over points scores, the decision of the CRSW Committee will be final.
11. In the event of a tie in both the Drivers and Co-Drivers Championships, the award will be to the competitor with the least number of counting scores and if a tie still exists to the driver with the smaller capacity car, or to the co-driver who in the opinion of the Committee has the lesser experience.
12. Awards will be presented at a date to be decided by the CRSW Committee following the end of the championship year.
